The W.B. National University of Juridical Sciences (NUJS) Kolkata recorded a ninety four percent (94%) placement for its graduating batch of 2016. The majority of students (93 students in a batch of 122) participated in the recruitment process and an overwhelming number of students (87 students) were placed, either by the Campus Recruitment Committee (CRC) or through offers outside the college recruitment process (as per the table below).

The recruitment process that started with Day Zero on 7 April, 2015 was satisfactorily completed on 1 July 2016. Amongst the many recruiters who came for the campus placement process, we take immense pride in the recruitment by various international law firms from our university. Not only did we have the top seven law firms and various corporates participate in the process again this year, but also a large number of companies that participated in the process for the first time after we engaged and connected with them.

The average annual package offered by foreign law firms was around INR 38-44 lakhs. Top domestic law firms offered an average package of around INR 15-18 lakhs, while the average package of corporate recruiters was in the INR 6-12 lakh range.

Our batch saw students take diverse career decision. While some students who did not opt to sit for recruitment diligently preparing for civil services examinations, others opted for higher studies in India and abroad.

Of course, this would not have been possible without the support of our respected Vice Chancellor, Prof. P. Ishwara Bhat, faculty advisor Ms. Vaneeta Patnaik, all the faculty members at NUJS and the CRC members. The incredible and fantastic support of our alumni network must also be acknowledged for the success of the recruitment process. The tireless efforts of our CRC coordinator Prateek Gupta and members Vikas Narain, Sanchit Garg and Gayatri Loomba deserve special mention.
